Using the map overleaf to help, follow the self-guided route on your smartphone and then walk the trail alone or with friends. The walk is web-based so you will need to open your browser and go to: **<http://tiny.cc/trailsof>** or scan the QR code [right]

There will be clues to find and evidence to gather – and the opportunity to take the weight off your feet in a friendly pub at your journey's end.

The route is accessible to pushchair and wheelchair users, and takes about 45 minutes to one hour to complete. It involves a hill or two and some hunting for picture clues. You can follow the route on a printed map (overleaf), but you will only be able to access the picture clues and narrative through a smartphone web browser. (Without giving too much away, you might also want to have a set of headphones in your pocket for later...!)

This trail is a prototype and, as such, may be (just occasionally!) subject to glitches - if it doesn't work for you, please accept our apologies - but please also let us know via the webpage.

When you begin, you will be asked to allow us to access your current location - please click YES otherwise it won't work...!

The route is based in Coventry city centre, some of the areas it visits are less used and may not be well lit after dark - we'd advise you to wear shoes which are ok to walk some distance in, take care when using routes that are also used by vehicles - and please exercise the same caution in waving your smartphone about that you would in any unfamiliar city centre environment, as Talking Birds can't be held responsible for any loss or damage suffered.

The pub at the trail's end allows children in up until 4pm.
